PUBLIC WORKS/UTILITY



The Village manages **10 parks** stretching over **400 acres**; **291 lane miles** of snow removal/debris collection; **105 miles** of sewer lines; **\$21 million** worth of equipment as well as maintenance of **6 wells** and **3 water towers**, over **100 miles** of water distribution mains, and **27,000 visits** annually to the yard waste facility.
