NEW UTILITY BILLING SYSTEM

The Village of Germantown recently completed the implementation of a new utility billing system for water and sewer utilities. The new system will allow the Village to provide a greater level of service and transparency to residents. The brand-new look of your utility bill will display separate lines for your water volume, sewer volume, quarterly sewer charge, quarterly water charge, and public fire protection charge.

In addition to the new utility bill, the Village has a new online portal for utility related activities. The Citizen Self Service Portal will be a one-stop shop that will allow residents to pay their utility bills, change their mailing addresses, change their bill delivery preferences, view consumption history, etc. Click below to access the new system or instructions on how to sign up.

2023 Road Improvements

This project was publicly bid on March 2nd. Payne and Dolan, Inc. submitted the lowest bid and will be awarded the contract pending approval from the Village Board. The roads included in this year's program are:

- Adams Court
- Bonniwell Road – Goldendale Road to Shadow Lane
- Church Street
- Country Belle Manor Subd. – 3 roads off of STH 175
- Glenwood Park Subd. – 5 roads off of Pilgrim Road
- Navajo Hills Subd. – 2 roads off of CTH Q
- River Lane – Bunsen Drive to Friestadt Road
- Sylvan Circle – Squire Drive to Pilgrim Road
- Western Avenue – Main St. to Mequon Road

- Concord – Pilgrim to Butternut south of Concord
- Broadleaf Lane – south of Concord
- Glenwood Road
- Burr Oak Road

Reminder: only one brush pick up this year in **June**. This is to accommodate buckthorn removal without spreading the seeds throughout the Village.





Project Update

FREISTADT ROAD, WIS 175 to CLOSE LONG-TERM



PROJECT STATUS

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is beginning a series of road improvement projects in Washington County throughout 2023. This work includes roadway improvements, scheduled bridge maintenance over I-41, and box culvert work. The following upcoming work is scheduled as part of these improvement projects:

Beginning March 20, 2023:

- **Freistadt Road (County F) is scheduled to close long-term** between Hilltop Drive and Johnson Lane through early summer 2023 for bridge maintenance.

Motorists are encouraged to use an alternate route to avoid the closure.

Beginning March 29, 2023:

- **Appleton Avenue (WIS 175) is scheduled to close long-term** between Holy Hill and Pioneer roads through summer 2023 for box culvert work. Access will be maintained to local businesses and residences within the project limits.

Detour: Motorists are encouraged to use Pioneer Road, I-41 and Holy Hill Road to avoid the closure.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
