COUNTY LINE ROAD to CLOSE OVERNIGHT

Paving Operations Scheduled for Ramps and Roadway



Project Status

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with a series of road improvement projects in Washington County. The following work is scheduled as part of these improvement projects.

**Monday, June 26,
through Thursday, June 29,
from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.**

- County Line Road between Rivercrest Drive and Cumberland Road is scheduled to close to traffic overnight.
- The entrance and exit ramps at I-41 and County Line Road are scheduled to close to traffic overnight.
- The intersection of Falls Parkway and County Line Road is scheduled to close to traffic overnight.

Eastbound County Line Road over I-41 is scheduled to remain closed until early July.

Detour Route

- » Motorists are encouraged to use Appleton Avenue (WIS 175), Lannon/Mequon roads (WIS 167), Main Street and Pilgrim Road to get around these closures.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
