

Project Update

I-41 SOUTHBOUND to CLOSE OVERNIGHT for BRIDGE WORK



Southbound I-41 Between Lannon Road and Holy Hill Road will Close for Bridge Deck Work

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with a series of road improvement projects in Washington County. The following work is scheduled as part of these improvement projects.



Monday, September 18, from 10 p.m. to 4:30 a.m.:

- Southbound I-41 is scheduled to close to traffic overnight between Lannon and Holy Hill roads while crews pour concrete for the Mequon Road bridge over I-41.
- Northbound I-41 is scheduled to be restricted to one lane from Lannon Road to north of Mequon Road while crews pour concrete for the bridge.
- The northbound entrance ramp to I-41 from Lannon Road is also scheduled to be closed.

I-41 Southbound Detour

- » Exit at Holy Hill Road (WIS 167) and travel west to Appleton Avenue (WIS 175)
- » Travel south on Appleton Avenue to Lannon Road
- » Travel east on Lannon Road to I-41 southbound

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
