COUNTY LINE ROAD to CLOSE OVERNIGHT



Bridge Paving and Roadway Repairs Scheduled

Project Status

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with a series of road improvement projects in Washington County. The following work is scheduled as part of these improvement projects.

The following closures are scheduled beginning Thursday, September 21, and for the following 10 nights, from 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.:

- County Line Road between Rivercrest Drive and Cumberland Road is scheduled to close to traffic overnight.
- The entrance and exit ramps at I-41 and County Line Road are scheduled to close to traffic overnight.
- The intersection of Falls Parkway and County Line Road is scheduled to close to traffic overnight.

Westbound County Line Road over I-41 is scheduled to be closed until late September.

Please note: No closures are scheduled during the weekend.

Detour Route

- » Motorists are encouraged to use Lannon/Mequon roads (WIS 167), Appleton Avenue (WIS 175), Main Street and Pilgrim Road to get around these closures.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
